RULES FILMING\PHOTOGRAPHY IN WEST COAST NATIONAL PARK

- 1. Always keep your permit with you in the event that a ranger wants to check it
- 2. No filming in bird hides or on boardwalks.
- 3. No vehicles allowed on beaches at any time.
- 4. No vehicles allowed (including no off-loading) on bottom parking (gravel) at Kraalbaai in front of rangers' office (green building).
- 5. No powered vessels permitted in the B zone of the lagoon.
- 6. All watercraft used on West Coast National Park waters during shoots must be in possession of a West Coast National Park boat permit (obtainable from the Conservation office in Langebaan).
- 7. No animals may be brought into the park.
- 8. No fires of any type are to be used in shoots.
- 9. No generators are permitted to be used.
- 10. All filming must take place during park gate hours. No exceptions. Gate times are:
 - April to August: 07:00 18:00
 - September to March: 07:00 19:00
- 11. For the purposes of these conditions "Crew" includes models\actors, family members and crew working on shoot.
- 12. Crews are not allowed to bring more people that indicated on the permit and then pay park conservation fees for the extra persons to enter the park.
- 13. Always (and only) adhere to instructions of West Coast National Park rangers when on location
